India — Delhi (Greater Noida), 22–24 October | Bangladesh — Dhaka, 25–27 October 2026

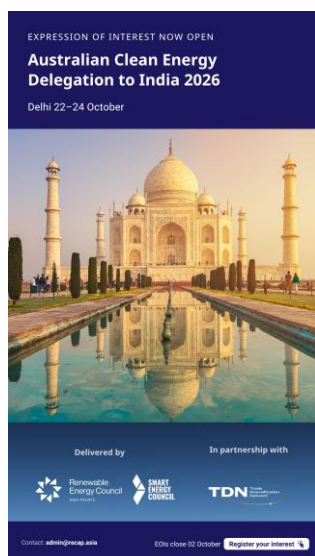
About the event

The Australian Government is leading the third Australian delegation of clean energy companies to two of South Asia's most significant growth markets. This program is supported by Team Australia, specifically the Department of Climate Change, Energy, Environment and Water, Austrade's **Accessing New Markets Initiative (ANMI)** and **State Government partners**. The **Renewable Energy Council Asia Pacific (RECAP)** is proud to be the delivery partner. This delegation connects Australian exporters with two strategically important South Asian markets in a single, efficient trip. It opens in India, timed to the Renewable Energy India (REI) Expo 2026 in Greater Noida, Delhi (22–24 October), which is one of Asia's largest renewable energy trade platforms and will include an Australian Pavilion presence, before moving to Dhaka, Bangladesh (25–27 October) for a dedicated clean energy mission into one of the region's fastest-emerging markets. Delivered as one integrated regional program, delegates can join both legs or either country's trade mission on its own.

The program brings together export-ready Australian companies across solar PV, battery and energy storage, smart grid, EV infrastructure, electrification and the broader renewable energy ecosystem to engage directly with Indian and Bangladeshi partners, investors and buyers.

India and Bangladesh are among the highest-growth clean energy markets in the Asia-Pacific region and strategic priority markets under Australia's trade diversification agenda. India's scale, ambitious renewable targets, and rapid solar and storage deployment sit alongside Bangladesh's immediate opportunities in rooftop solar, distributed energy and grid modernisation; these markets are best accessed through a trusted, government-backed delegation.

By joining the delegation, you will:

- Gain deep insights into the Indian and Bangladeshi clean energy markets, with expert briefings from Austrade's in-market teams
- Engage directly with local partners, investors, EPCs, developers and buyers through curated B2B and business matching sessions
- Showcase your technology and capabilities at the Renewable Energy India Expo — all confirmed delegates will have their company logo on the Australian Pavilion delegation wall, with opportunities for product display and speaking slots subject to availability
- Build commercial partnerships and explore export, distribution and joint-venture opportunities across two markets in one trip

- **Industry roundtables, networking and government engagement**

Curated Australian delegation networking, industry roundtables and engagement with government, utility and regulatory stakeholders where feasible. Your business will be matched to potential partners in-country.

- **Bangladesh — Dhaka clean energy mission (25–27 October)**

Mission leg into Dhaka with a welcome reception, curated business meetings, workshop with the local industry association to broaden your in-country networks, and site and institutional engagement across Bangladesh's emerging rooftop solar, distributed energy and grid modernisation opportunities.

- **Post-mission follow-up support**

Tracking of commercial leads, facilitation of follow-up introductions, and collection of delegate feedback and market insights.

Insights: the India and Bangladesh markets

India is one of the world's fastest-growing renewable energy markets, driven by large-scale solar and storage deployment, ambitious national renewable targets, grid modernisation and rising demand for smart, digitalised energy solutions. The Renewable Energy India Expo is a premier platform for engaging Indian developers, EPCs, distributors and investors.

Bangladesh offers significant emerging opportunities in rooftop solar, distributed and behind-the-meter energy, battery storage and grid modernisation, as the country accelerates its clean energy transition and seeks international technology and investment partners.

Together, the two markets give Australian companies access to both a large, mature-scaling market and a fast-emerging one — in a single, government-backed regional program.

Key market drivers include:

- India's ambitious 500 GW renewable energy target by 2030, driving rapid solar, storage and grid investment
- Strong and growing demand for solar PV, battery storage and smart grid solutions across commercial, industrial and utility sectors
- Expanding electric vehicle and e-mobility ecosystem creating new electrification opportunities
- Grid modernisation and transmission investment opening pathways for Australian technology and services
- Bangladesh's accelerating rooftop solar and distributed energy market, driven by energy access and grid reliability priorities
- Growing demand in Bangladesh for behind-the-meter solar, battery storage and hybrid energy systems
- Both markets actively seeking international technology partnerships, investment and expertise.

India and Bangladesh's combination of scale, growth ambition and open market conditions make them priority destinations for Australian clean energy companies seeking high-growth South and South-East Asian opportunities.
